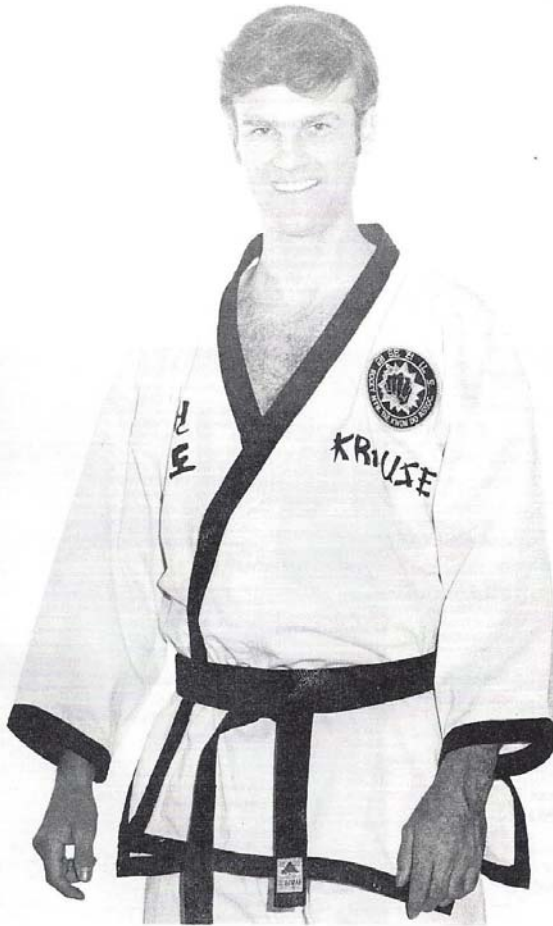

Greetings




